Of all Beatrix Potter's enchanting stories perhaps the best-known and most loved are Peter Rabbit and Benjamin Bunny. They were in fact among the first stories she published, Peter Rabbit in 1902 and Benjamin Bunny in 1904. They go naturally together for the same characters appear in both books — Peter and his brothers and sisters, Flopsy, Mopsy and Cotton-Tail; their cousin Benjamin Bunny; and the old gardener, Mr. McGregor.

Nothing could improve on the original words used by Beatrix Potter and in this dramatised version they are used throughout. In addition, however, there are some delightful songs sung by some of the characters — in particular "Why do I do it?" sung by Peter Rabbit himself who is always looking for trouble. Lyrics are by David Croft and original music by Cyril Ornadel.

Vivien Leigh makes an enchanting narrator.
